RULES

1. The competition is open to all Kent Floral Art members who have paid their affiliation NAFAS fee, except for the Kent Floral Art Photography representative, who may not enter the competition.
2. Class 6 is the novice class. A novice is someone who has not won a 1st, 2nd or 3rd placement in a Kent or National NAFAS photography competition.
3. Entry Fee: There is no charge to enter the competition in any class.
4. No image that has previously won an award in any Kent Floral Art or national NAFAS Photography Competition may be entered into this competition.
5. No image can be entered into more than one class.
6. No more than three entries in any one class are allowed.
7. No manipulation except basic overall adjustment faithful to the original image is allowed.
8. Entrants submitting images of floral exhibits should, as far as possible, acknowledge the arranger or state if the exhibit is the photographer's own work.
9. All images must have been taken by the competitor.
10. The judge's decision is final.
11. Images should be sent in jpg or jpeg format and must be a minimum of 2000 pixels in width or height, depending on the aspect (portrait or landscape).
12. Images should be emailed separately (one per email) to the Competition Secretary, with **"2022 Photography Competition"** in the subject line to pauline.pearce@virgin.net and the completed entry form (Page 2) should be posted or emailed to the address below.
13. By entering this competition, you are agreeing to the future use of your image(s) by Kent Floral Art in any form, whether electronic or in print.

HOW TO ENTER

STEP ONE:

Submit each individual entry by email with *2022 Photography Competition* in the subject line to the Competition Secretary – pauline.pearce@virgin.net before the deadline of 5 pm **Saturday 16th April 2022.**

IMPORTANT: Please send your entry **AS AN ATTACHMENT** (not as an image in the body of the email). Please ensure that your image/s is sent at full or 'actual' size as some email applications automatically reduce the size before sending.

Please include the following information in your email:

- Your name
- Your address and postcode
- Your telephone number
- Your email address
- Your Flower Club name
- The number and title of the class you are entering
- A *brief* description of the image (e.g. who designed a floral exhibit, or where a landscape image was taken)

STEP TWO:

- Print out the entry form on page 2 and either scan & email it, or post it to the address below. Once your entry form has been received your digital image will be entered into the competition. Your entry form is required so that we have your signature and so that we can ensure that we have received all of the entries expected.
